⁽¹⁸⁾This is how the birth of Jesus Christ came about. His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph; before their marriage she found she was going to have a child through the Holy Spirit. ⁽¹⁹⁾Being a man of principle, and at the same time wanting to save her from exposure, Joseph made up his mind to have the marriage contract quietly set aside. ⁽²⁰⁾He had resolved on this, when an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, 'Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home with you to be your wife. It is through the Holy Spirit that she has conceived. ⁽²¹⁾She will bear a son; and you shall give him the name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins.' ⁽²²⁾All this happened in order to fulfill what the Lord declared through the prophet: ⁽²³⁾'A virgin will conceive and bear a son, and he shall be called Emmanuel,' a name which means 'God is with us'.
